

Wings of Wonder 2018 Pre-Flight Checklist

- **Date:** Saturday, June 23, 2018
- **Time:** 11:00am-4:00pm (To ensure a flight please arrive no later than 3:00pm. You will be scheduled to fly upon arrival. In order to make sure that we are ready for you, please do not plan to arrive before 10:45am.)
- **Location:** Burke Lakefront Airport, 1501 N. Marginal Rd., Cleveland, Ohio
- **Directions:**

From the West: Follow Interstate 90 east to Route 2 West (Lakewood), continue on Route 2 (Shoreway) to East 9th Street exit. Turn left then right again at the first corner onto N. Marginal Road.

From the East: Take Interstate 90 west, stay on Route 2 West. Continue on Route 2 (Shoreway) to East 9th Street exit. Turn right then right again at the first corner onto N. Marginal Road. Or exit at East 55th and follow N. Marginal Road.

From the South: Take Interstate 77 north, exit at East 9th Street. Go north, at the intersection with the Rock n' Roll Hall of Fame and Museum, turn right onto N. Marginal Road.

Parking Info: Follow N. Marginal Road east and turn Left at the F4 airplane display at the front of the airport property. The parking area is immediately to the left. The route will have signs to assist you in finding your way. Guests who are unable to walk from the parking area to the terminal may be dropped off in a designated area in front of the terminal. Please attempt to travel in one vehicle per family. Have your KIF parking pass to submit to parking attendant and KIF representative at check-in.
